

## CODICIL

If you have an existing will but would like to include a gift to Kingston Grammar School, you can do so by adding a codicil. The wording below is illustrated as a starting point for you to liaise with a solicitor on.

"In addition to any legacies given in my will, I give Kingston Grammar School the sum of  $\pounds$ ....... or ......... share of my residuary estate to be used in line with the School's need at the time. In all other respects I confirm my will and any other codicils to it."

Once you have completed your codicil, you will have it witnessed by two people who are not related to you or to any person mentioned in your will, just like the full will and testament. You will need to store the codicil with your will.
